Gun maker sets sights on safety first in annual shooting season

THE age-old tradition of shooting is not only a local custom but a hobby with great depth and a widespread community of passionate enthusiasts.

Gareth Rule, of established family-run gun makers AW Rule & Son in Somerton, spoke to the Western Gazette to give us a brief insight into the gun-making business and the world of shooting.
Gareth comes from a prestigious gun-making pedigree and this has in turn furthered his interest in the entire industry of shooting and developed his passion for the sport.

The family business was originally formed by Gareth's father Anthony "Tony" Rule in the late 1960s after he moved to Somerset following his ten-year gun-making apprenticeship with world renowned master craftsman James Purdey.

In 1990, Gareth's father transferred his business from Langport and had a workshop built into the family home, which first introduced a young Gareth to the shooting world, igniting his passion for the industry.

After leaving school, Gareth completed a four-year apprenticeship as a gunsmith then a six-year full apprenticeship in gun stockmaking under his father. He now runs the family business.

Having been around guns for 20 years it is no surprise that Gareth is passionate about shooting as well as gun making. He said: "It's an interest that stems from a passion for the whole industry, from the history and tradition to the equipment and attire. Every aspect plays its part in making the experience on the day the best it can be."

One of the factors in ensuring

misfire or gun malfunction is to ensure your gun is regularly serviced, Gareth said.

He added "People that go game shooting should have their guns serviced every 12 to 18 months, our primary role is maintenance with of course our top priority being safety.

"Even If you have only fired a gun once during the year, a service is a must, as there's every chance there could be congealed oils or a number of other factors affecting its function. As we say, a dirty gun is a dangerous gun.

For many people shooting is an exciting but somewhat alien prospect, with many unaware of how to get involved, or what game shooting really entails.

Gareth said: "The place to start is clay pigeon shooting, as it is open all year round and creates an environment where you can sample the sport without necessarily buying all the equipment. "Going clay pigeon shooting is also a good way of integrating into a shooting community. Networking and socialising at these events will give you the oppertunity to integrate yourself with a group of

ing and socialising at these events will give you the opportunity to integrate yourself with a group of game shooters who may invite you to join their shooting parts. "Initially you will most likely be invited to go beating, Beating is where you flush the birds out from cover. This startles the birds so they fly out and reveal themselves."
